
Venue

Exhibition Information for WHS Regional Meeting 2026

Why Exhibit?

Exhibitors can benefit from a ready market of over 2,000 delegates, comprising policymakers, thought leaders, governments, financial institutions, development partners, and technology providers, all focused on developing new frameworks, policies, and approaches for health sector.

Exhibition Costs

- Standard Booth 9 m square (3 m x 3 m) USD 2,000
- Standard Superior Booth 18m square (3 m x 6 m) -USD 4,000
- Signature Booth 27 m square (3 m x 9 m) USD 8.000
- Classic Booth 36 m square (6 m x 6 m) USD 12,000



Exhibition Guidelines

- Exhibitors with a booth of more than 9 square meters must register a maximum of 4 booth attendants, while those with 9 square meters will register 2 booth attendants.
- 2. Exhibitors are required to set up their stands for the exhibition on 26th April 2025, with all exhibition materials to be delivered to the venue by 6:00 pm on the same day. This ensures readiness for the exhibition's opening on 27th April 2025. Breakdown will take place immediately after the exhibition, at the latest by 11 am on 30th April 2025.
- The venue will not provide storage for exhibition goods before build-up and after the specified period for breakdown.
- 4. Single-phase power will be available for all exhibitors, with the option for three-phase power upon request, provided the exhibitor supplies power distribution boxes and three-phase cables. Technical support will be offered by the event organizer.
- 5. Exhibitors will access the venue through the Parliament
- 6. For safety reasons, exhibitors will only be allowed access to the exhibition area from 7.00 am to 6.00 pm.
